Now in its fifth year, GLAMFA will occupy five CSULB art department galleries and will include works in a range of mediums. This year GLAMFA is actively encouraging submissions from dance, design, film, music, theater, visual arts, and writing programs. Past GLAMFA exhibitions (2005-2008) have featured a diverse community of artists from thirteen schools: Art Center College of Design, California Institute of the Arts, California State University Fullerton, California State University Los Angeles, California State University Northridge, Claremont Graduate University, Otis College of Art and Design, University of California Irvine, University of California Los Angeles, University of California Riverside, University of California San Diego, University of California Santa Barbara, and University of Southern California.

- **Email submissions are preferred.** Send JPEG files (72 dpi) to the email address listed below.
- CDs of images will also be accepted by mail. Applicants with dance, film, or video should submit DVDs (QuickTime files) by mail. Submissions by mail should be accompanied by an email notification.
- **NO** slides or photographs will be accepted.
- There is no limit to the number of works each artist may submit, but all work should have been completed as a graduate student.
- All submissions must include resume, statement, and annotated slide list (including title, year, media, and size for each artwork included).
- For return of submission packets include SASE.
